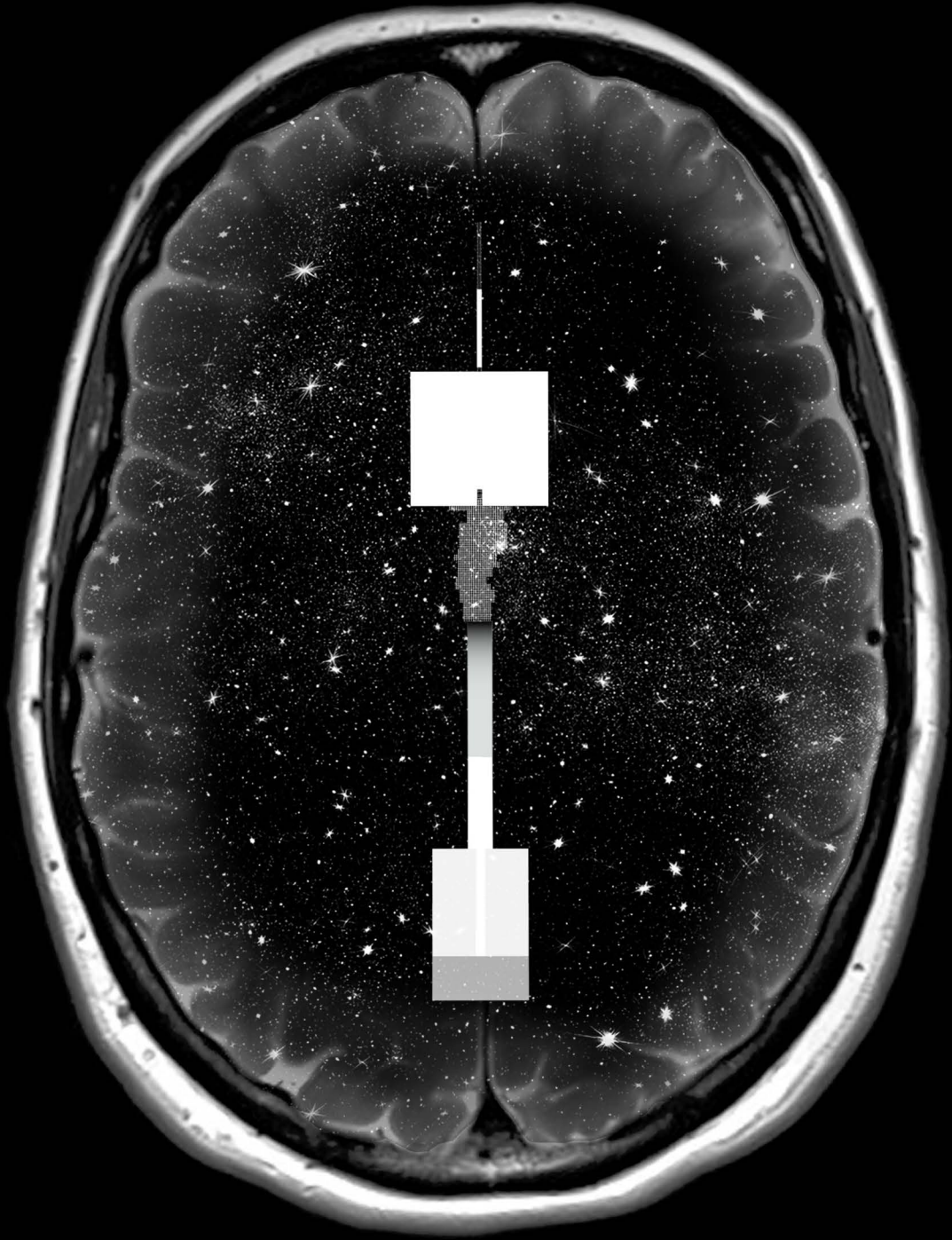

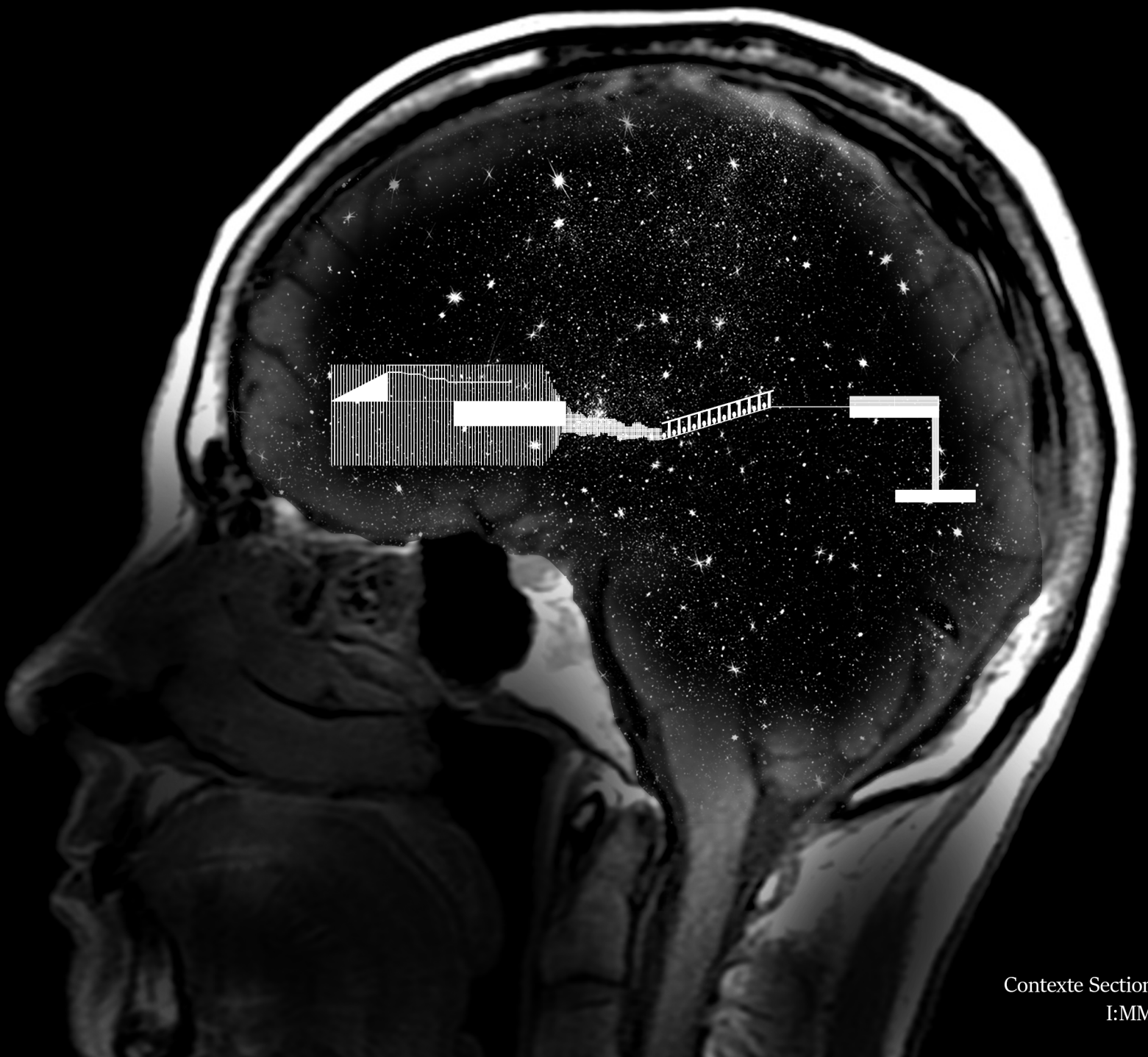

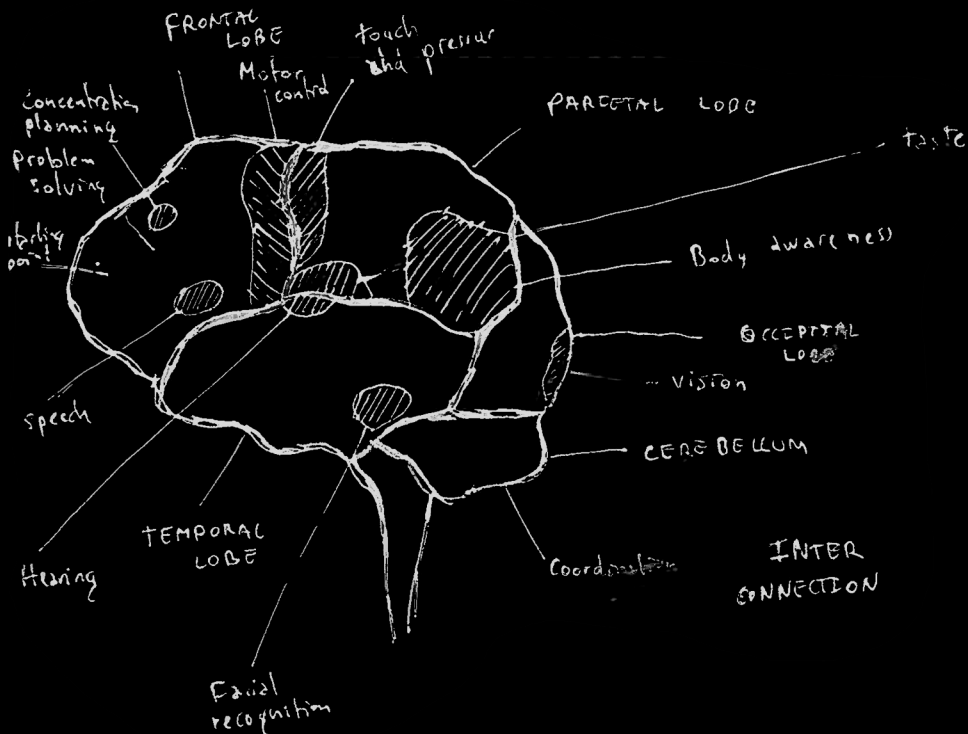

The Mind Palace of the Pharaoh

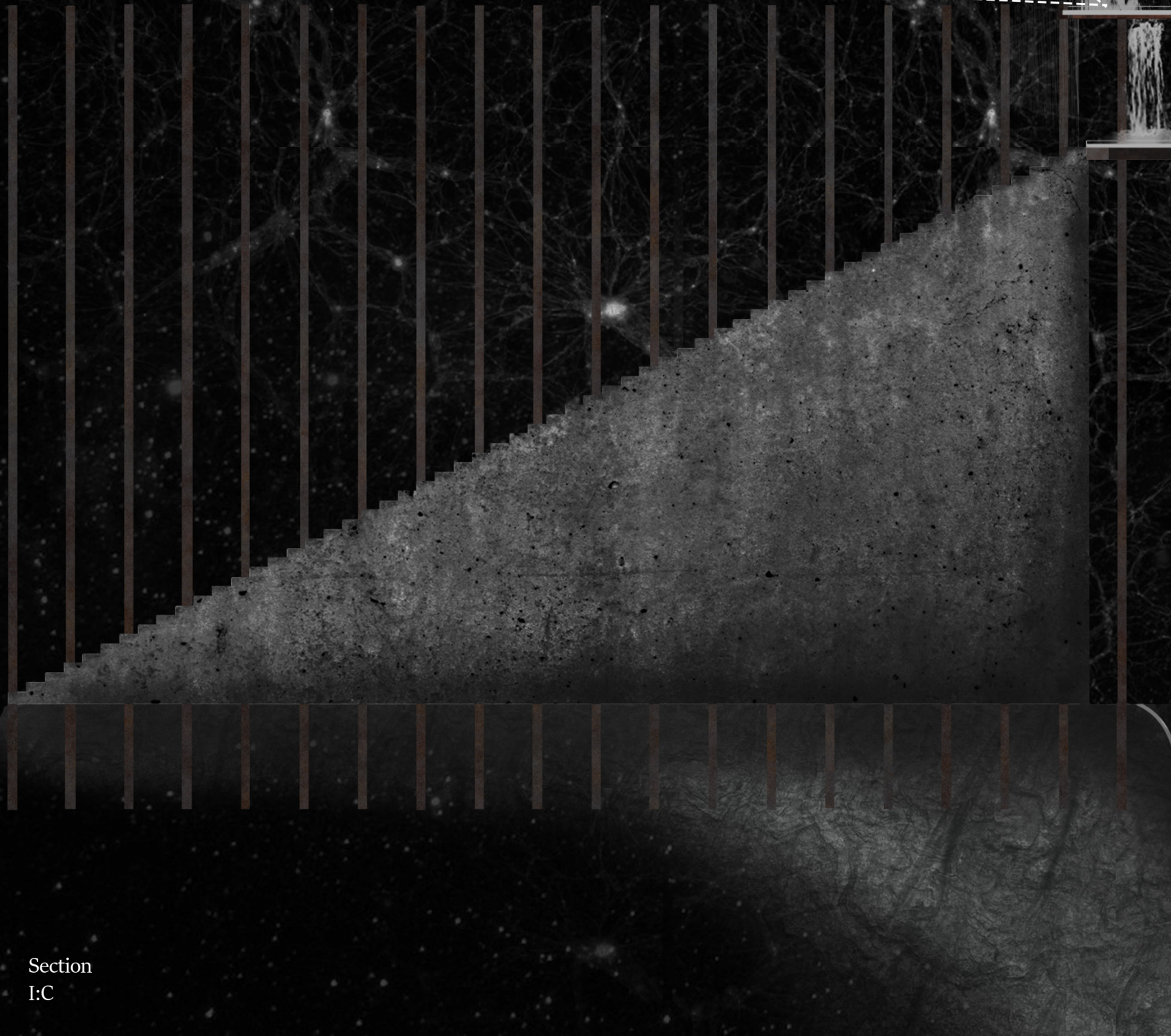
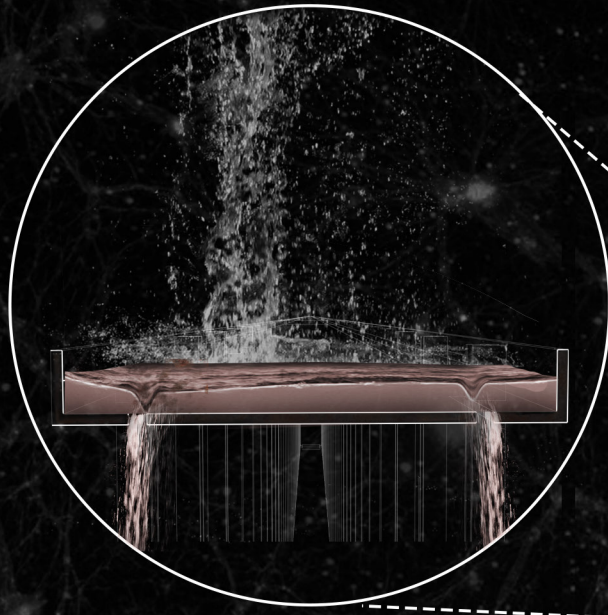

Axonometric section







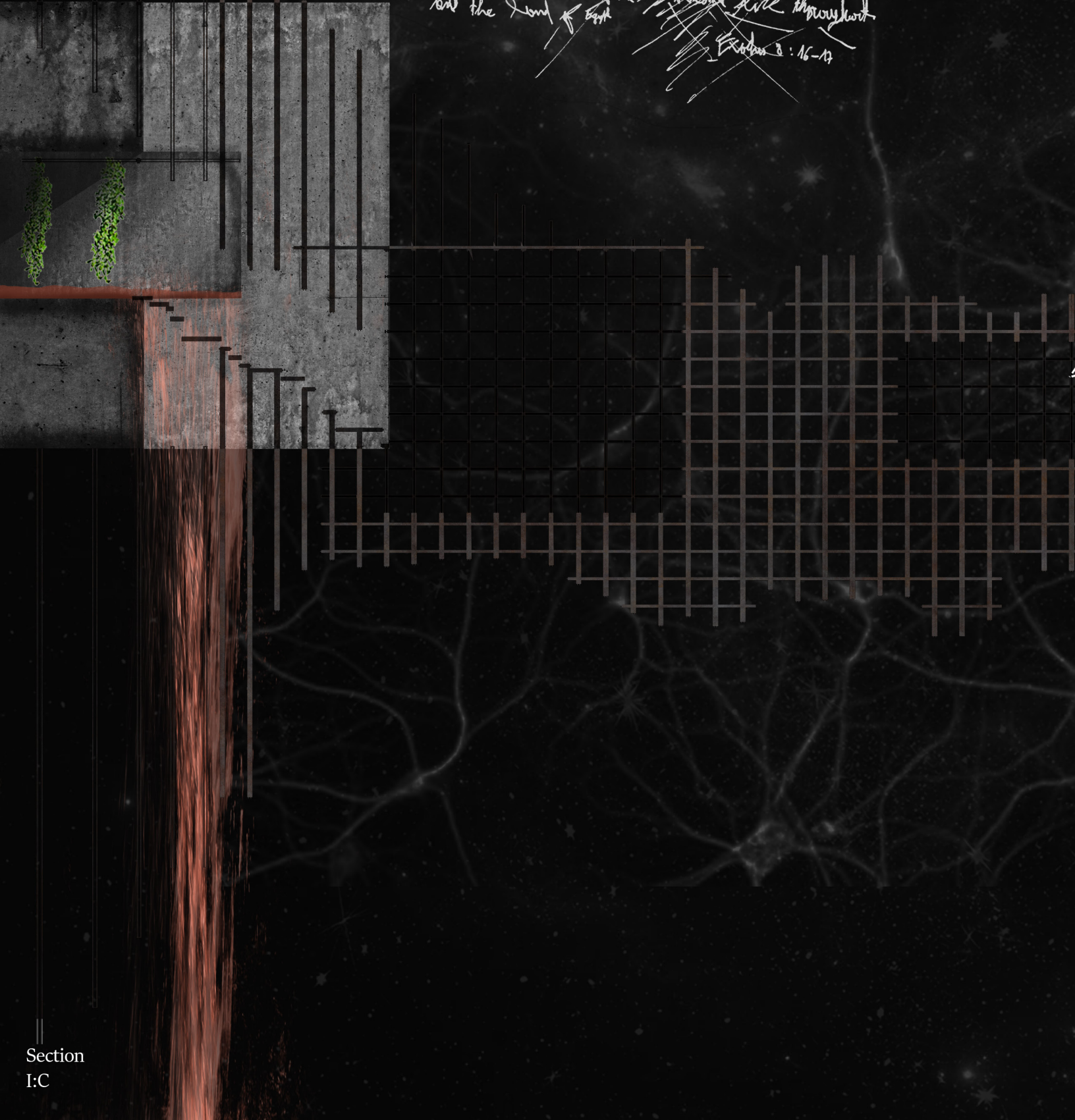


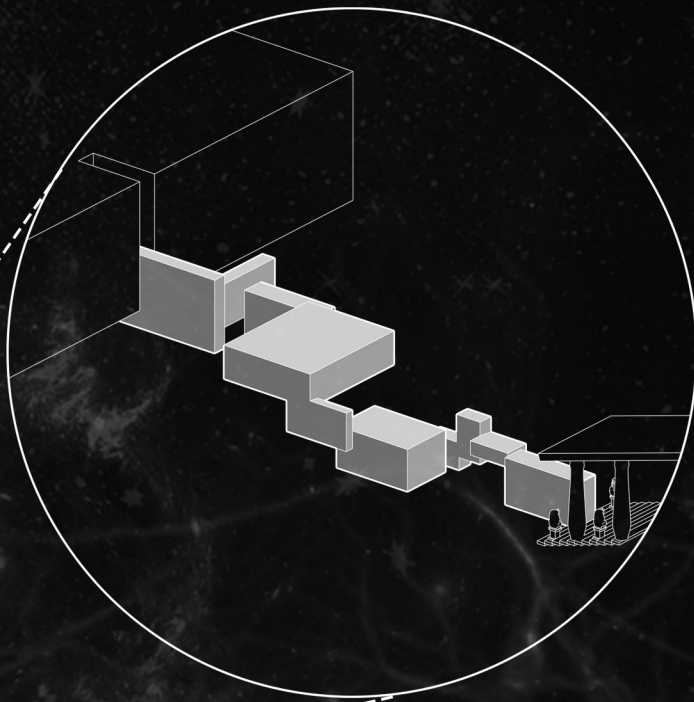
