

| List or recommended electives (2021-22)

You will find below **(1)** a list of recommended electives for 1st year students, and **(2)** a list of recommended electives for upper year students (2nd, 3rd and 4th year) in the Architectural Studies (BAS) program at Laurentian University.

BAS students must complete 24 elective credits during their 4 years in the program.

These sample lists of recommended electives were put together by the Undergraduate Coordinator and include courses offered in other Departments that can support architectural studies. **It remains your purview to use this list or not.**

It is your responsibility to verify whether these courses are being offered this year, to ensure that you are eligible and that your choices do not conflict with your BAS timetable. Please note that some pre-requisites can be lifted or revised under special circumstances; contact the Undergraduate Coordinator for more information: BAS@laurentian.ca

Each **course code** gives you an indication of the:

- level of difficulty for the course (**first number**)
 - ANTR-1007EL-01 is considered a first year level / introductory course
 - ENGL-3536EL-01 is considered a 3rd year level / advanced course, but you can still register as a 1st year student
- mode of delivery for the course (**last two numbers, either starting with a 0 or a 1**)
 - ANTR-1007EL-01 and ENGL-1706EL-04 are in person courses (or remote/ hybrid mode for 21-22 exceptionally)
 - ENGL-1540EL-12 and HIST-3066EL-10 are online courses

Online courses are **not live**, while in person courses (including remote or hybrid) are taught **live**.

| List for 1st year students

Students entering the 1st year of the program must register to 6 elective credits for the Fall semester and to 6 elective credits for the Winter semester (unless they received transfer credits).

Please note that students entering the program and wishing to complete a **Minor** (24 credits) in a specific program must consult with the Undergraduate Coordinator.

Students entering the **3rd year** of the program (on the typical academic path) must register to 3 elective credits for the Fall semester and to 3 elective credits for the Winter semester (unless they received transfer credits).

Students entering the **4th year** of the program (on the typical academic path) must only register to 3 elective credits for the Fall semester (unless they received transfer credits).

Students who are completing a **Minor** should make sure to **register** – please consult with the Undergraduate Coordinator.
